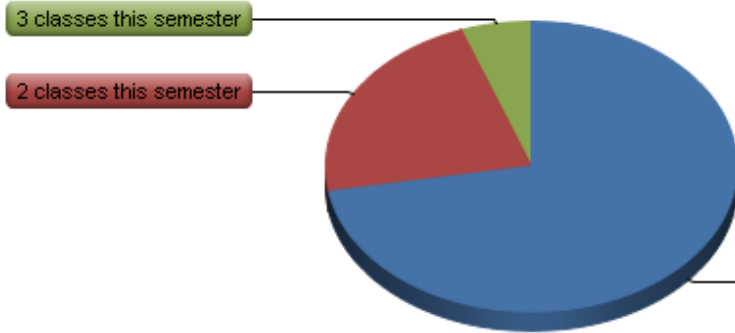

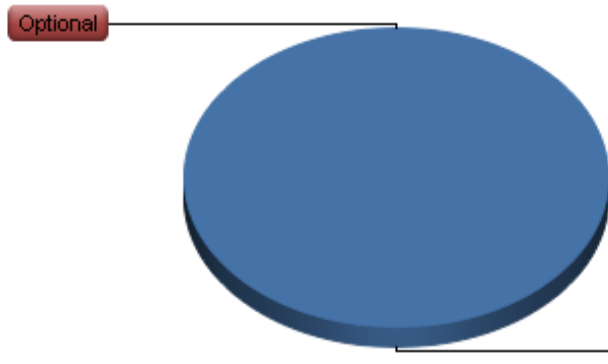

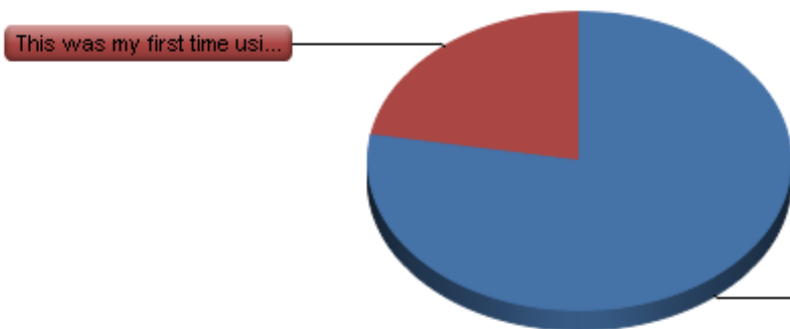
I used clickers in:

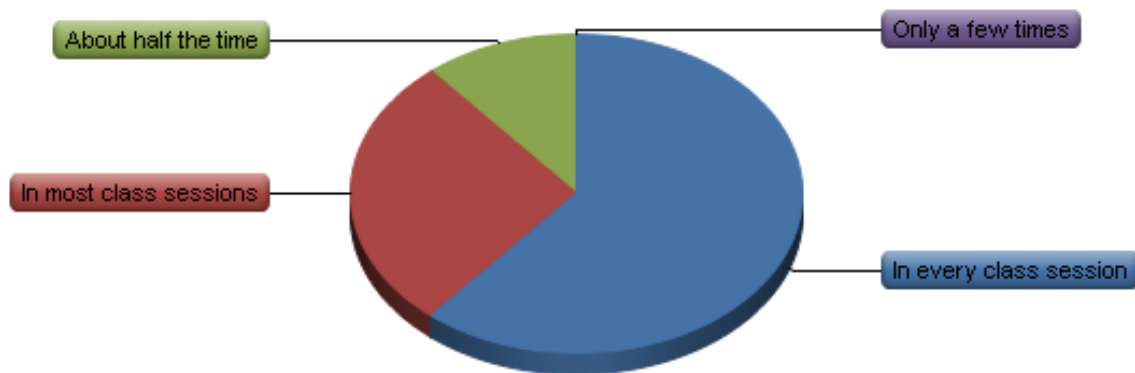

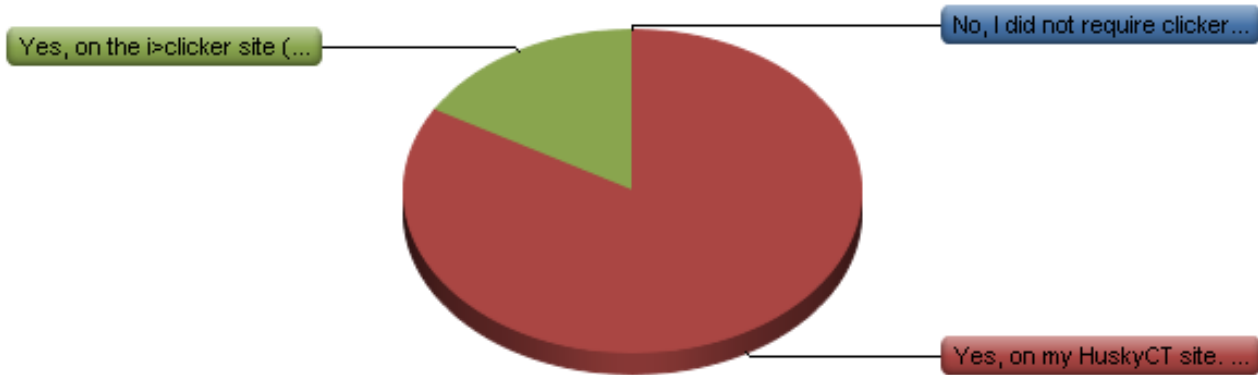

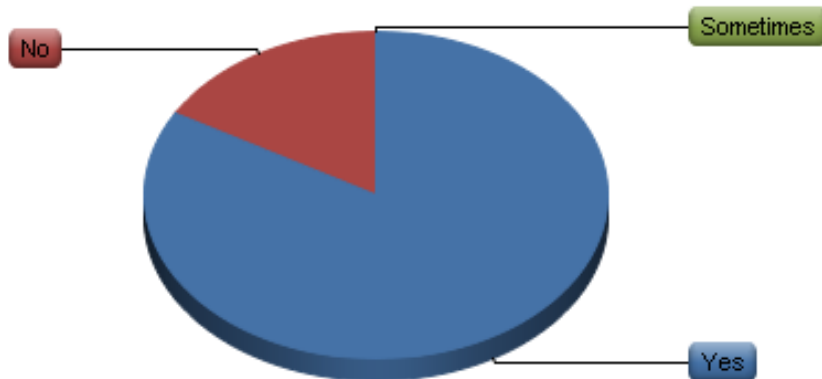

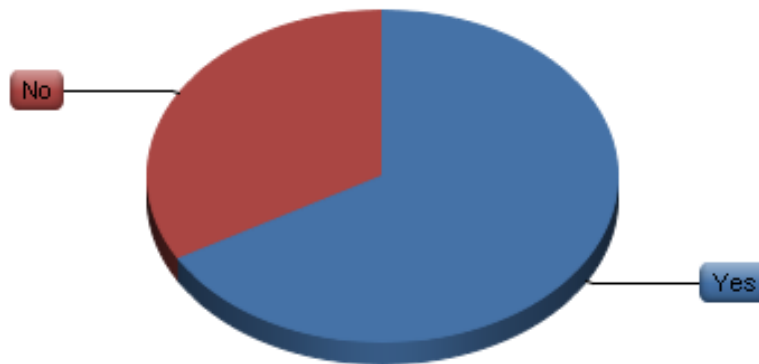

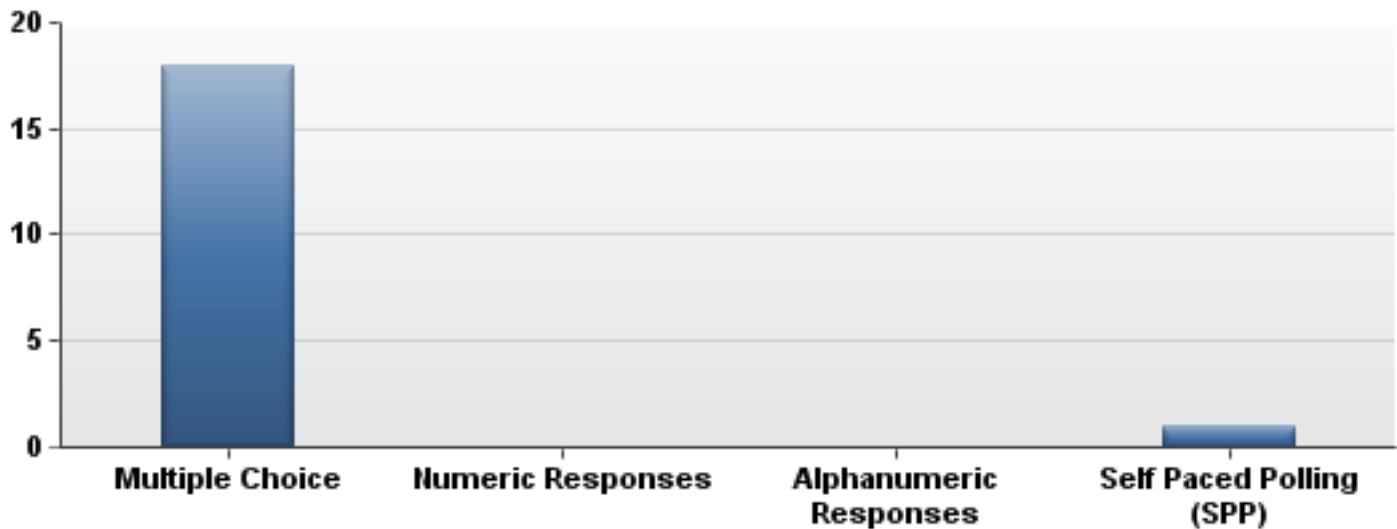

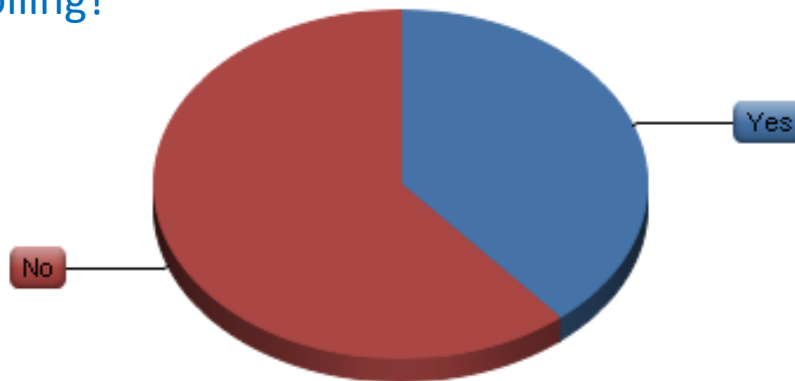

Self Paced Polling

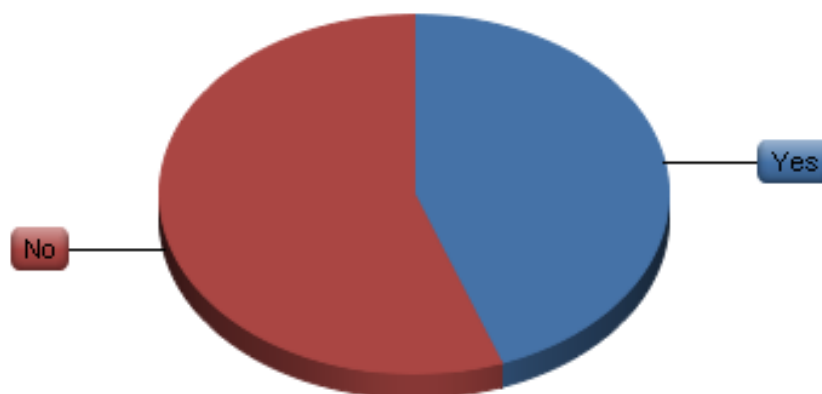
Self Paced Polling allows students to respond to a series of questions at their own pace. Would you be interested in learning more about Self Paced Polling?

i>clicker GO

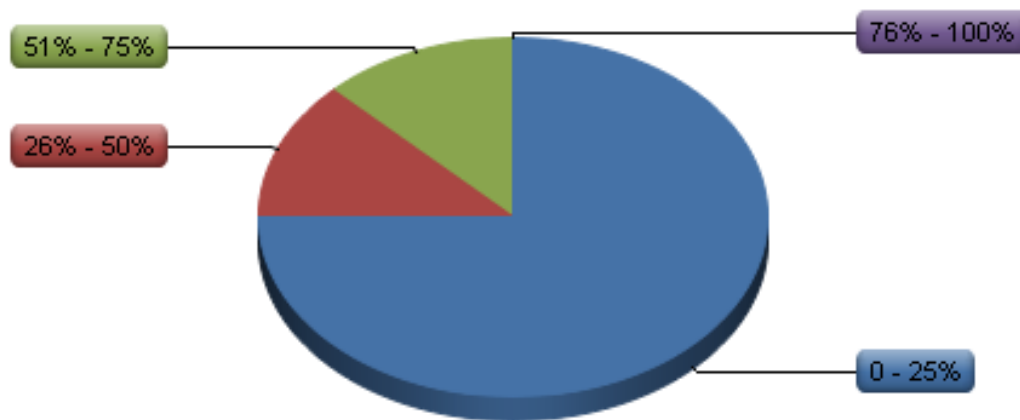
i clicker GO is software that enables students to respond to i>clicker questions in class with a smart phone or laptop. Did you use i>clicker GO?

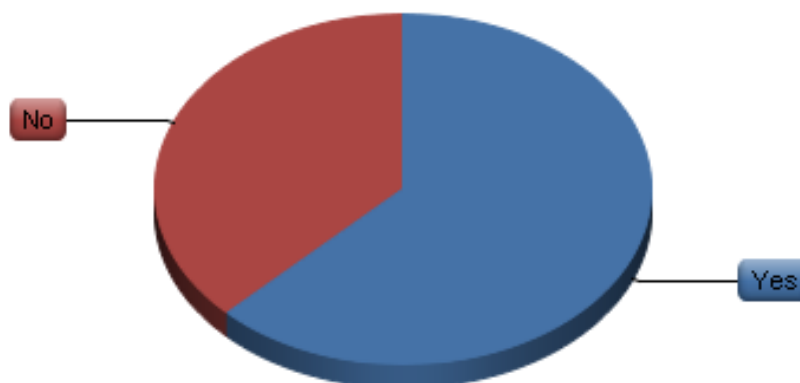

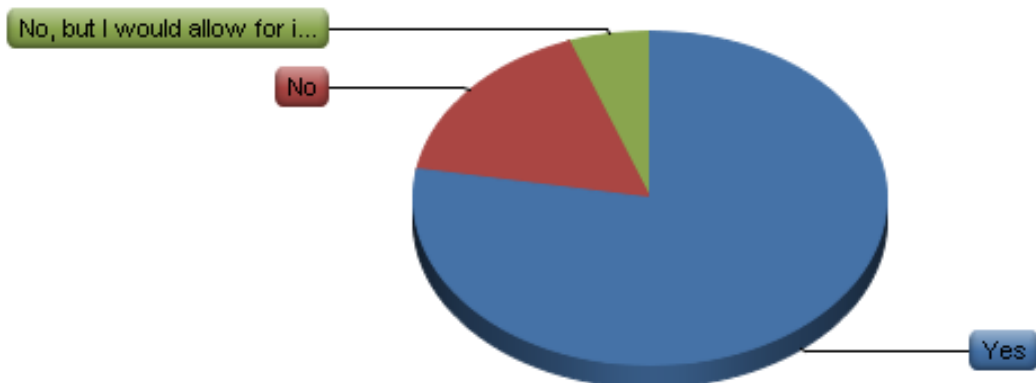

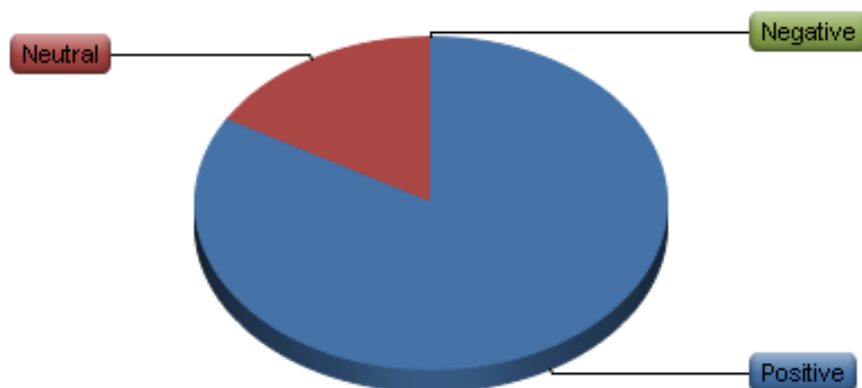

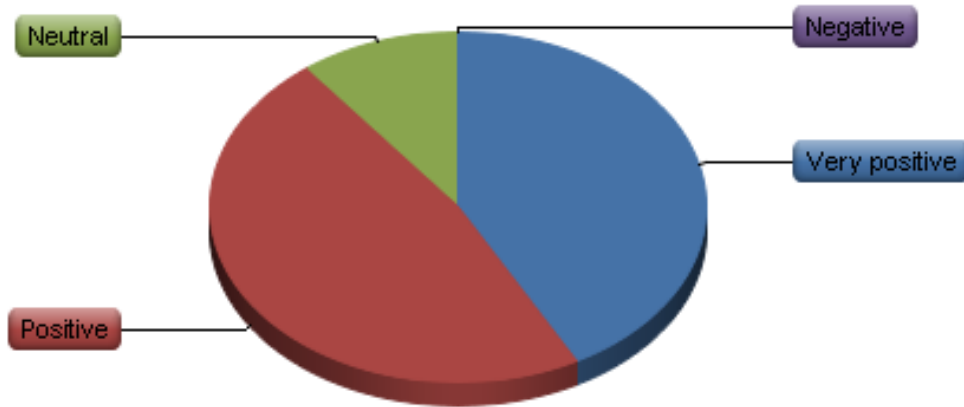
